Meeting Minutes Thursday, 01/21/2021 (via Zoom)

Minutes from 11/19/2020 meeting were approved.

Status of PE2 Tasks:

GHG Inventory (Carroll and Toy): Attendees discussed the VOL Greenhouse Gas Inventory document and provided feedback to the current version – preparing it for release to the trustees.

There was a discussion on VOL electricity cost differences between 2013 and 2019.

Status of PE3 Tasks:

Energy Benchmarking for Government Buildings (Hardaway): Attendees dicussed a draft resolution to be presented to the trustees to gather energy usage data in Energy Start Portfolio Manager.

Status of PE4 Tasks:

Solar Energy Campaigns: Moll discussed solar energy campaigns within the VOL for Clean Energy Communities participation. Carroll provided information on the requirements for launching and documenting the impacts of a community solar campaign. Carroll and Moll to work on a CEC scoping document for the campaign.

Green Power Procurement Policy (Moll): Moll reported that VOL streetlights could not connect to the VOL Solar Farms NY contract/campaign.

VOL Tree Bank: Moll raised a question about the VOL Tree Bank policy/law could fulfill a future CSC action step. Carroll and Toy stated that action steps were changing and to wait and see if a new/updated action step might be appropriate.

Innovative Ideas: Task force discussed potential new ideas.

- Painting rooftops white residential/businesses.
- VOL's new Sidewalk Committee
- Pedestrian master plan
- Xeriscape landscaping reduction of fossil-fuel maintenance vehicles and watersmart landscaping.

Status of PE7 Tasks:

Solar Installations and Power Purchase Agreement: Task force discussed future solar installations in the Village (not much land available for installations.) Power purchase agreements are probably the best way to go.

TC Hazard Mitigation Plan: Hardaway discussed VOL's participation in the Tompkins County Hazard Mitigation plan and how this plan will help the county and the village to prepare for impacts of climate change.
