HEATSmart Presentation

Lisa Marshall gave a brief presentation on HEATSmart.

- Moll asked about a Village campaign. 10 signups are required for a successful campaign: 3 heat pumps and other 7 can be insulation installations.
- HeatSmart: requires community outreach, yard signs, etc. HeatSmart can provide materials to assist including yard signs.
- Task force plans to approach the trustees to commit the Village to a HeatSmart campaign.
- Marshall had sent a sample resolution and other materials to launch the campaign.

Discuss Climate Action Plan (Rachel Zevin)

- CSC/CEC Task Force needs to review the draft then the trustees must review the draft and eventually approve it for release.
- Zevin will deliver a draft for review before the next task force meeting (07/15/2021).
- Task Force wants to add dates to emission-reduction goals as they are reviewing the

- CAP draft document. Zevin will highlight locations of needed dates and numbers in the draft.
- Zevin asked for permission to sign in to online workspace for this document and supporting materials.
- Zevin and TF members agreed to support Town of Lansing's clean energy actions if needed.
