## **VOL Greenway Committee**

Meeting Minutes

## Thursday, 02/29/2024

Attendees: Ronny Hardaway, Carolyn Greenwald, and Larry Bieri

The meeting was called to order at 1:32 PM.

- Update of Village Trails Google Map
  - Bieri reported that he updated a Google Map with the Village trails.
  - Hardaway asked Bieri to send him the KLM file that can be imported into the existing Greenway Google Map.
  - There was a brief discussion about Graham Road West improvements by the 2024 capital project.
  - Bieri raised the need for a sidewalk extension on the south side Uptown Road.
- Update on Greenwald/Hardaway meeting with John Courtney
  - Hardaway discussed the information from Greenwald's and Hardaway's meeting with John Courtney about plans for this year.
  - Hardaway discussed the recent IP-address failure and how the issues was resolved with Inmotion Hosting.
  - Courtney agreed that a sidewalk plan was a good idea.
  - Update on Sidewalk Policy and associated capital plan
    - Greenwald shared her updates to the draft sidewalks and walkways policy.
    - The task force reviewed her changes in the meeting and made additional revisions to the document.
    - The document still needs details in several sections.
    - There was a discussion about including a list of future trails in the policy that would be updated on an as-needed basis.
    - [There was a diversion into a discussion of updating the Village's Comprehensive Plan, see below.]
    - Hardaway suggested finding and referring to the Village Code that addresses sidewalks.
    - Hardaway suggested making Appendix A part of the policy rather than an appendix.
    - Greenwald suggested adding a VOL-TOL connecting trail in the document. *There was a brief discussion about the possible paths for the connecting trail.*
    - Hardaway and Bieri are to review the current document before the next GW meeting.

- Comprehensive Plan Update
  - Greenwald mentioned that the Village Comprehensive Plan needed to be updated. Hardaway asked Greenwald to lead the Comp Plan update, and she agreed to lead the effort.
  - Greenwald raised the idea of applying for a grant to assist with a Village Code gap analysis. The Town uses the services of John Collier for their gap analysis.
  - Greenwald recommended that a member of the public be included in the Comprehensive Plan update committee.
  - Greenwald to raise this topic at the next trustees' meeting.
- Status of Tompkins County Beautification Grant
  - Grant application was submitted. The grant awards will happen by early April.

The next meeting will be March 28.
